By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to the official respondents to arrest the accused persons and their accomplices, who are “roaming freely” and are threatening the petitioner (as alleged), and further, to complete the investigation and submit a status report in case FIR no.53 dated 23.07.2019, registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib, Tarn Taran, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 302, 201 and 120-B of the IPC. A further prayer has been made that respondents no.1 and 2 be directed to get the matter investigated in a fair and impartial manner in the aforesaid FIR, with the investigation to be supervised by a senior IPS officer.

Pursuant to the order of this court dated 21.02.2020, an affidavit of the SSP, Tarn Taran, dated 15.12.2020, is on record, stating therein that other than Sahab Singh @ Sabu (the petitioner in the accompanying petition by which he seeks to be admitted to bail), neither his family members nor the *Sarpanch* was found to be actually guilty of the commission of the

offences and consequently a report under Section 173 (2) of the Cr.P.C. was prepared accordingly, with which the SSP has agreed.

Learned State counsel submits that it has now been submitted to the competent court.

That being so, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

Obviously, if the petitioner, who is stated to be the husband and father of the two deceased persons and the complainant in the FIR, is aggrieved of the report in any manner, he would have his remedy before the competent court.
