Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 restraining them from implicating the petitioner falsely in criminal cases as he was earlier involved in case FIR No.128 dated 25.06.2021 under Sections 379 and 411 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was implicated falsely in case FIR No.128 dated 25.06.2021 and his application for anticipatory bail was allowed by Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur vide order dated 15.07.2021 (Annexure P-1). According to him, the police is likely to involve him in other cases as well as his co-accused have been involved. He prays that the directions be issued restraining the official respondents from

implicating the petitioner.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by Mr. Arora, learned counsel that petitioner is not involved in any other case except the above mentioned FIR No. 128 dated 25.06.2021 and no notice has been issued by the petitioner in respect of any other case.

Considering the above background, no ground is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
