Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for setting aside the impugned reply/rejection dated 05.05.2021 (Annexure P-4) issued by the respondents to the legal notice dated 19.02.2021 submitted by the petitioner whereby the claims made by the petitioner have been rejected illegally and arbitrarily.
