The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to grant protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate security/police protection to the petitioners and also directing the respondent Nos. 4 to 6 not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioners.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that both the petitioners are major and they are of marriageable age and they have already got married with each others vide Annexure P-3. The certificate of age has been attached as Annexure P-1 and P-2. He further submitted that a representation was given to Superintendent of Police, Panchkula vide Annexure P-4 through registered post but no action has been taken by the police for grant of protection to the petitioners. He further submitted that there was threat to the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and, therefore, the present petition has

been filed for the grant of protection.

At this stage, Mr. Deepak Manchanda, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has submitted that he has got instructions from ASI Arvind Kumar and states that both the petitioners have already got their statements recorded before the police authorities and they have stated that now they do not have any threat from the private respondents and they do not need any protection because the matter has been settled.

In view of the above, no further proceedings are called for in the present case and, therefore, the present petition is rendered as infructuous.

However, if at any stage, the petitioners apprehend any threat in future then they can certainly take recourse to the appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
