Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.144 dated 21.09.2018, under Sections 304B and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

By virtue of the order dated 21.01.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hoshiar Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 21.01.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
