The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation into the alleged forgery, fraud and cheating committed by Revenue Official (respondent No.4) in connivance with arrayed private respondents wherein the revenue records were forged by respondent No. 4 and for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to register an FIR against the arrayed private respondents.
