The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through these applications (CM-2412-CI-2020 and CM-650-CI-2021), the appellants pray for preponing the date of hearing and for disposal of the appeal in terms of judgment passed by the High Court in RFA No.7824 of 2013 decided on 23.10.2019.

Pursuant to the notice, the Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estate, Gurugram, Haryana, has filed a reply, the same is taken on record, admitting that the dispute in the present case with regard to the amount of compensation is covered by the decision passed in RFA No.7824 of 2013 on 23.10.2019.

At the time of hearing, Sh. Samarth Sagar, Addl. AG, Haryana, did not dispute the correctness of the aforesaid assertion made in the reply.

Hence, applications are allowed and the main appeal is taken on

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board today itself for final disposal.

In view of the admitted position, the appeal is disposed of in terms of the judgment dated 23.10.2019 passed in RFA No.7824 of 2013. It is not in dispute that both of these appeals arise from the same notification under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, issued on 13.01.2010, for acquisition of land at public expense for public purpose, mainly for development and utilisation of land for Sector Roads of sector No.99 to 115 at Gurugram.

Ordered accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
