AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking directions for impartial and expeditious investigation in FIR No. 21 dated 9.3.2021, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 380, 148 and 149 IPC along with DDR No. 38 dated 11.3.2021, under Sections 324, 323, 379, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghanie Khe Bangar, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the State appearing on advance notice, on instructions from ASI-Amarjit Singh, submits that these are cross cases. The matter was being investigated, in the meantime an application was moved by one of the accused and enquiry was held in which the petitioner was also joined. She further submits that the enquiry report is ready and the petitioner can get the copy thereof from the concerned office on a working day.

In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of grievances, if any.

From the statement made by learned counsel for the State, it is evident that the matter is being investigated. In such circumstances, no further directions are called for. However, the petitioner is granted liberty, as prayed for.

The petition is disposed of.
