Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take legal action against private respondents and their associates for misappropriation of property of petitioners by impersonation and for extending threats to eliminate the petitioners or to involve them in false cases with further direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representations dated NIL (Annexures P/2 and P/3), representations dated 23.09.2020, 20.01.2021 and 28.04.2021 (Annexures P/7 to P/9 respectively) to respondent No.4-Inspector General of Police, Border Range, Amritsar, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion confined to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4-Inspector General of Police, Border Range, Amritsar, to look into and decide representations dated NIL (Annexures P/2 and P/3), representations dated 23.09.2020, 20.01.2021 and 28.04.2021 (Annexures P/7 to P/9 respectively) in accordance with law by passing speaking orders and that too within two months positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
