The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had lodged a complaint against the private respondents and when he went to the police station, he was physically assaulted and made to sign on a blank papers. He submits that before approaching this Court, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 06.07.2021, a copy of which has been sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla-respondent No.3. However, according to the counsel, the representation has not been attended to. He submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the representation dated 06.07.2021, Annexure P-1.

Request made by counsel has been considered.

Without examining the allegations made in the writ petition or in the representation submitted by the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla - respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 06.07.2021, Annexure P-1, and take suitable action thereon as warranted, in accordance with law.

A copy of the order as well as copy of the representation be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla - respondent No.3, in order to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
