The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served, however, he remains unrepresented.

On 24.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.08/2021, titled as 'Balwinder Singh vs. Amandeep Kaur' pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Fatehgarh Sahib to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Camp Court at Nabha, District Patiala.

The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 16.02.2020. She claims that at present, she is residing with her parents at Nabha, District Patiala and cannot properly defend the petition at Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the respondent (husband) is already facing trial in a petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C in District Court, Camp Court at Nabha, District Patiala.

The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the respondent through his counsel Sh. Rajinder Singh Mehta, District Court, Fatehgarh Sahib.

Since the respondent has not entered appearance, therefore, the

facts noticed in the aforesaid order dated 24.08.2021, remain uncontroverted.

Hence, the petition is allowed.

The petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.08/2021, titled as 'Balwinder Singh vs. Amandeep Kaur' pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Fatehgarh Sahib, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Camp Court at Nabha, District Patiala.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 14.10.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
