The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.66 dated 2.7.2021 registered under Section 498-A I.P.C at Police Station, Women, District Ludhiana.

By virtue of the order dated 27.7.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 27.7.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. Counsel further submits that petitioner and complainant have resolved their dispute and they are living together. This fact has been confirmed by learned counsel for the complainant.
