This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.127 dated 23.05.2021, under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 473, 120-B and 34 of the IPC and Sections 103 & 104 of the Trade Mark Act, 1999, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

[2]. The petitioners have remained in detention in the present case for more than 3 months, since 23.05.2021.

[3]. After completion of the investigation, Challan against the petitioners has already been submitted, but trial could not commence due to ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic. Moreso, the Charges are yet to be framed.

[4]. In these circumstances, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioners, the prayer of the petitioners for regular bail is allowed

and they are ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
