Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that present writ petition has
been filed for directing the respondents to grant/release retiral benefits of
the petitioner for the service rendered by him from the date of his joining
i.e. 7.7.1988 till his superannuation on 29.2.2020 along with interest on
delayed payment. He further submits that for relief which is being claimed
by the petitioner in the present writ petition, the petitioner has already
moved legal notice dated 4.1.2021 (Annexure P-3) to the respondents,
which is still pending consideration with the respondents. He has further
stated that the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound
direction is issued to the competent authority to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. APS Gill, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of
respondent No.1 while Mr. Kshitij Sharma, Advocate, accepts notice on
behalf of respondents No.2 to 5. They submit that they have no objection if

direction is given to the competent authority to decide legal notice

(Annexure P-3) in accordance with law.

In view of above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide legal notice (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
