By filing this petition, quashing of FIR No.151 dated 13.07.2020 registered under Sections 379, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners has been sought on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 25.08.2020 and subsequent order dated 14.10.2020 of this Court, parties were directed to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned for recording their statements and trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report of learned JMIC, Fazilka has been received wherein it is stated that compromise entered into between the parties which is voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence from either side.

In view thereof, the petition is allowed. FIR No.151 dated 13.07.2020 registered under Sections 379, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka and all other subsequent proceedings arising

therefrom qua petitioners, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
