The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.148 dated 12.8.2015 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

On 29.7.2021 following order was passed:

"The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This is a fourth petition seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.148 dated 12.8.2015, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender. That order has been set aside. Now the matter has been compromised.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab and Mr. Atul Kaushik, Advocate appearing on advance notice accept the same on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2, respectively.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 submits that quashing petition was filed in which notice of motion has been issued.

Considering the change in circumstances, let the petitioner appear before the trial court within one week from today. In case of her surrender, she will be released on interim bail by the court concerned.

Adjourned to 16.8.2021."

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satinder Pal Singh submits that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and was granted interim bail.

In view of above, no further orders are called for.

Disposed of.

It is clarified that while making the interim bail absolute, the Sessions Court would be at liberty to impose any conditions, if required to ensure the presence of the petitioner.
