Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner who is alleged to have been working as Beldar/Worker on daily wages for the last more than 28 years.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 30.11.2019 (P-11) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice (P-11) in

accordance with instructions issued upto date by passing speaking order preferably within a period of four months from today.
