LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of 'continuous mandamus' seeking Court monitored investigation in regard to the dispute (civil and criminal) between petitioner and respondents no.7 and 8.

Heard learned senior counsel for the petitioner.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner is unable to deny that entire dispute as mentioned in the writ petition arose after the demise of Baba Daya Singh (father of the petitioner and respondent no.7), who bequeathed his entire property which is situated in a number of villages to the petitioner and respondent no.7 in equal shares vide Will dated 25.06.2013 (Annexure P1). Dispute between the brothers has given rise to multifarious civil as well as criminal litigation between petitioner and respondents no.7 and 8.

It is borne out from the writ petition that necessary steps are being taken by the administration to ensure maintenance of law and order. Number of FIRs have been registered and proceedings under Section 145 Cr.P.C. have been undertaken at various places and Receiver appointed.

I do not find any ground whatsoever to interfere at this stage for monitoring the multifarious litigation between two private parties. Needless to say, in case of any emergent situation the administration would at all times take necessary steps for ensuring maintenance of law and order.

This writ petition is dismissed.
