The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they are facing threat from private respondents No.4 and 5.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent No.4 is the son and respondent No.5 is the daughter-in-law of the petitioners and the relations between them have turned sour. He submits that a civil suit has been instituted by the petitioners against them wherein a declaration has been sought that the petitioners have no concern with the private respondents. He submits that in this background, petitioners apprehend a threat to their life and liberty from respondents No.4 and 5. He submits that

before approaching this Court, the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 07.07.2021, Annexure P-3, which is not being attended to. It is submitted that the petitioners will be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the representation, Annexure P-3.

Request made by counsel has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegation levelled in the writ petition or in the representation, Annexure P-3, submitted by the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali - respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 07.07.2021, Annexure P-3, and to take appropriate steps thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation, Annexure P-3, be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali - respondent No.2, to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
