Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this fifth petition, the petitioner seeks interim bail in case bearing FIR No. 358 dated 08.9.2018 under Sections 34, 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Sections 4, 5 and 6 of the Prize Chits and Money Circulation Schemes (Banning) Act, 1978, registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contend that vide order dated 10.06.2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench in CRM-M-3724-2021, the petitioner was granted interim regular bail for a period of 15 days, on the ground that his wife had been sick and suffering from Multiple Left Renal Calculi & Urinary Infection and there was nobody to look after his three minor daughters. Thereafter, vide order dated 25.06.2021 passed by this Court in CRM-M-24127-2021, the interim bail granted to the petitioner was extended for a period of two weeks.

Learned counsel further contend that the petitioner still requires to be with his ailing wife as she needs a clinic, pathological and cardio logical assistance.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ashok Singh Chaudhary, Addl. A. G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, and submits that the petitioner had surrendered back in time post the expiry of the interim bail granted to him on earlier occasions.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the health of the wife of the petitioner coupled with the fact that he has also to look after his three minor children, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim regular bail w.e.f. 31.07.2021 to 16.08.2021, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Fatehabad. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the concerned Jail Authority, on 16.08.2021 at 3.00 P.M. sharp.

Disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
