Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 to 5 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.6 to 12, who have started harassing and humiliating him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner alongwith 30000 candidates appeared in a written test, conducted on 24.10.2019 at 11.00 P.M. to 12.30 A.M. (midnight); that many candidates had taken the written test in the residential houses; that the petitioner had paid Rs.7 lakh to respondents No.8 to 10 for getting a govt. job, but they had returned the same to him because one Amarjit Singh, resident of village Akliya, District Bathinda, had paid more amount for the said job.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1, 6 and 7 only, at this stage.

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On the asking of this Court, Ms. Anita Balyan, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1, 6 and 7, and submits that a Staff Court of Inquiry was conducted into the matter and respondents No.6 and 7 were not found to be blameworthy.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition.
