Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0180 dated 22.05.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat.

The FIR was registered on the complaint of one Kishore, who stated that he had taken contract for constructions of the house of one Nanha resident of village Shera. Some female workers were engaged by him as labour. The petitioner and the co-accused, namely Meeta, who were residing in the neighbourhood of Nanha used to misbehave with the female labourers and the complainant scolded Beena and Meeta. It is alleged that on 18.05.2021, when the complainant and others were going toward their house after completing the work the petitioner and co-accused took them towards bushes of drain. The petitioner caught hold of the complainant and co-

accused Meeta had broken a glass bottle of liquor and assaulted him on his face with the broken bottle. Thereafter, another blow was given by him with the bottle on his chest. On raising alarm, the accused persons fled away from the spot. As per the MLR, one injury on the person of the complainant was opined to be grievous, which was stated to be caused by the sharp edged weapon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the said injury was attributed to her co-accused.

The investigation in the case is complete. Petitioner is in custody since 10.06.2021.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner-Beena @ Parveen is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
