The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.126 dated 1.7.2021 registered under Sections 354, 356, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 28.7.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation and thereafter, Section 379-B IPC was added in the FIR and petitioners again joined the investigation in pursuance to order dated 24.11.2021.

Learned State counsel affirms the same.

Investigating Officer SI Shubhpreet Kaur was summoned, who is present in person. She filed her affidavit dated 30.11.2021, which is taken on record.

I have interacted with the officer, who has tendered unconditional apology for the lapse of adding Section 379-B IPC later on.

Apology is accepted. The Court expects that the officer would be cautious in future.

Learned counsel the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, the orders dated 28.7.2021 and 24.11.2021 are made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
