Prayer in the present application is for impleading complainant-Shashi Bhushan son of Hukam Chand resident of Tyagi Mohalla, Badshahpur, District Gurugram, as respondent No. 2 and also to place on record the amended memo of parties.

Notice of the application.

On the asking of this Court, learned State counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that he has no objection, if the application is allowed.

In view of the above, the application is allowed. The amended memo of parties is taken on record.

Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.

Main case:

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 145 dated 13.07.2020, registered under Sections 147, 148, 332, 333, 353, 186, 452, 506 IPC, at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been compromised.

At this stage, Mr. Rajesh Bansal, Advocate, appears and files memorandum of appearance on behalf of the complainant, the same is taken on record. He does not dispute the factum of compromise.

Vide order dated 25.08.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 25.08.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mahesh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 25.08.2020 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
