Vide this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.22, dated 19.03.2021, having been registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 22 (a and c) and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Pursuant to the order dated 28.07.2021, learned State counsel submits, on instructions, that the petitioner has joined investigation and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

It is of course to be noticed that an affidavit dated 26.08.2021 has also been filed on behalf of the respondent State, simply stating that the petitioner has joined investigation.

The reply is ordered to be taken on record.

In view of the fact that the investigating agency itself does not require custodial interrogation at this stage, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 10 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.
