Vide this application, the applicant (petitioner in the accompanying petition), seeks to place on record a representation stated to be made by him to the SSP, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, on 10.8.2021.

No notice having been issued in the accompanying petition, none is required to be issued in this application which is consequently allowed subject to all just exceptions and a copy of the aforesaid representation is taken on record as Annexure P-7, in the company petition.

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The petitioner being essentially aggrieved of the order of learned Additional Sessions Judge, SBS Nagar, dated 29.6.2021, by which the petition filed by respondent No.2 under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C for the second time, has been allowed, on account of the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC having been deleted from the FIR, and

the representation of the petitioner, to the SSP, SBS Nagar, being in that respect only, at this stage it is considered appropriate to dispose of the petition with a direction to the SSP, SBS Nagar, to go into the matter and to take a decision on the representation of the petitioner, Annexure P-7, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, i.e. as to whether the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC was actually correctly deleted in the circumstances from the FIR, or should not have been deleted.

Naturally, if the petitioner is aggrieved of any decision taken by the SSP, SBS Nagar, he would always have his remedy in law available.
