Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this second petition, petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.135 dated 05.11.2016 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Laddowal, District Ludhiana.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 29.10.2021 of the Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Ludhiana, already filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Para No.14 of the petition would read as under:

*“That, the petitioner is not involved in any other F.I.R. under N.D.P.S. nor any such F.I.R. is pending or he has been convicted”.*

Whereas, as per Para 5 of the aforesaid reply, the petitioner is a habitual offender and is involved in six more FIR, out of which three stands registered under the NDPS Act and three under the Excise Act.

Since the petitioner has not approached this Court with clean hands, I do not find any ground to grant him the concession of regular bail.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
