Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 143 dated 23.10.2019 registered under Sections 22/25/29/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the orders dated 26.08.2020 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amar Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide dated 26.08.2020 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
