The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to extend the same benefit to the petitioners as has been granted to similarly situated pensioners by quashing the order dated 12.12.1997 (Annexure P-1) with further prayer to consider and consequently revise the pensionary benefits, for which, legal notice dated 01.03.2021 (Annexure P-6) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners side, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to

duly consider legal notice dated 01.03.2021 (Annexure P-6) as representation of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay as per law.
