LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioner is aggrieved of action of respondents in not counting service rendered by him with Kendriya Vidyalaya Baramula, Jammu on the sanctioned government post for the purpose of qualifying service towards pension/pensionary benefits in terms of decision of this Court in CWP-4783-2009, CWP-14238-1991 (Sukhdev Singh and others versus State of Punjab and others) and Harnandan Singh versus State of Punjab and others 2007 (2) RSJ 437. It is submitted that despite submission of legal notice dated 26.07.2020 (Annexure P6) no action is being taken by the authorities.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts the prayer for a direction that legal notice dated 26.07.2020 (Annexure P6), be finally decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 at this stage.

Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 and does not raise any serious objection to the limited prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, but without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide legal notice dated 26.07.2020 (Annexure P6), by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
