The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.282 dated 11.08.2020 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Jind.

In pursuance to the order dated 04.11.2020, the parties appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Report dated 15.03.2021 has been received from the Mediation Centre to the effect that the parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement/agreement. In para 9 of the settlement it has been *inter alia* agreed between the parties that the complainant will not oppose the present petition.

Vide order dated 26.08.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was

released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 26.08.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
