This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Challenge in the instant petition is to a show cause notice dated 06.07.2021 (Annexure P-9) issued by the Estate Officer, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, Rewari contemplating eviction from the property in question and served upon the petitioner under Section 18 (1) of the HUDA Act, 1977.

Counsel for the petitioner would vehemently contend that detailed reply to the show cause notice dated 15.07.2021 (Annexure P-10) has been filed but no final decision in the matter has been taken till date and on the other hand the HUDA authorities are proceeding ahead to enter mutation in its own name.

We find that there is no material/documents placed on record that would substantiate the apprehension that has been voiced by the petitioner.

Since an advanced copy of the petition had been served upon the respondent-Pradhikaran, Mr.Sandeep Moudgil, learned Addl.,AG, Haryana has joined proceedings and informs the Court that he has instructions from Mr.Vijay Rathee, Estate Officer, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, Rewari that a final decision in the matter pursuant to the reply dated 15.07.2021 submitted by the petitioner would be taken as expeditiously as possible and in the meanwhile no coercive steps would be initiated.

In the light of such categoric stand taken on behalf of the State, no intervention in the matter is warranted.

A show cause notice having been issued and the petitioner having responded to the same, it is the respondent-Pradhikaran which ought to take a final view in the matter.

Disposed of.
