The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

It is not disputed that in the petitioner's trial the entire prosecution evidence has been led.

In view of the above, at the fag end of his trial, the petitioner is held not entitled to the grant of bail. However, subject to the petitioner's cooperation, directions are issued to the Trial Court to dispose of the petitioner's trial within two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in accordance with law.

It is clarified that in case the petitioner's trial is not disposed of within the aforesaid period, after showing that such delay is not attributable to the petitioner, he shall be entitled to renew his prayer for regular bail.
