Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of a direction to respondent No.1 to conduct fair and independent investigation in FIR No.29 dated 03.04.2019 under Sections 148, 323, 452 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC (offence under Section 325 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Khamanon, District Fatehgarh Sahib, from some independent agency or from senior police official not below the rank of IPS of some other district with further direction to respondents No.1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that grievance of the petitioners would be satisfied in case the instant petition is treated as representation on behalf of the petitioners and if the same is ordered to be disposed of by respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, to treat the instant petition as representation and to look into and decide the same in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
