Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to fix the basic pay and seniority (notionally) of the petitioners vis-a-vis the other employees appointed from the same selection, as per the order dated 13.07.2016 (P-7) and 23.11.2016 (P-8) because the delay in their appointment is not attributable to them, but the same was due to wrong implementation of the judgments dated 08.10.2010 (P-1) and 01.05.2013 (P-2) by respondent Nos.1 and 2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that at this stage, his clients would be satisfied in case, representation dated 20.04.2021 (P-10) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Addl.A.G., Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the consensus arrived at between both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 20.04.2021 (P-10), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from today.
