Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioner for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.0135 dated 08.04.2019 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Udyog Vihar, District Gurugram.

Report dated 05.10.2021 has been received from Mediation and Conciliation of this Court comprising of compromise deed dated 04.10.2021, in terms of which, matter has been compromised between petitioner-Shashank Lakhotia and complainant-Tarun Malik and resultantly complainant-Tarun Malik has received an amount of Rs.20,00,000/- (Twenty Lakhs only) through draft bearing No. 505656 dated 04.10.2021 drawn on ICICI Bank from petitioner-Shashank Lakhotia in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for respondent-complainant has no objection in case interim pre-arrest bail already granted to petitioner-Shashank Lakhotia is made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from quarter concerned, submits that in compliance of order dated 12.06.2019, petitioner has already joined investigation and he is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

In view of above, order dated 12.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
