The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* quashing the impugned order dated 20.08.2020 (Annexure P-16) and order dated 22.01.2021 (Annexure P-18) passed by the respondents vide which the claim of the petitioner's husband for grant of old pension scheme and other benefit counting the ad-hoc service followed by regular service has been declined with further prayer for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the

respondents to allot General Fund Account Number; grant the pension to the petitioner's husband under Old Pension Scheme; refix the date of regularization after counting the service rendered during adhoc period and count the adhoc service followed by the regular service for qualifying service for the purpose of pension and other benefits, for which, representation dated 04.03.2021 (Annexure P-23) has also been submitted before the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the representation dated 04.03.2021 (Annexure P-23) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
