Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

Petitioner seeks parole in FIR No.192 dated 12.6.2016
registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh under Sections
147, 148, 149, 285, 302, 307, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act.
According to him, during his custody period, a mobile phone was recovered
from him for which a separate case was registered against him which is still
pending and the petitioner is on bail. He relies upon **Gurdeep Singh v.
State of Haryana and others**; CRWP-1374-2017 decided on 7.12.2017 to
contend that he is entitled to parole in view of the ratio in the said judgment.

Learned State counsel, however, points out that no application
has been moved by the petitioner for parole. In case any such application is
