This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking directions to officials respondents to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondent.

Petitioner who is 83 years old is a victim of ill treatment meted out by respondent No. 4 (his younger son). He also alleges being threatened and maltreated by him. In this regard, petitioner has submitted a representation (Annexure P-6) to respondent No. 2 (Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala.

Without in anyway commenting on the merit of case and opining on veracity of contents of representation, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 (Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala) to look into representation (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that he would advice the petitioner to pursue more efficacious remedy under the provisions of Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.
