Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.165 dated 11.06.2021, under Sections 376 (2) (N), 506, 323 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-17, HUDA, Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar.

By virtue of the order dated 02.08.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is still ready to marry with the petitioner, however, she is not agreeing to the same.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that though the petitioner is ready to marry the complainant, however, the same is subject to number of conditions. The allegations and counter-allegations shall be dealt by the learned trial Court on the basis of the evidence produced by the parties and the same cannot be appreciated, at this stage.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 02.08.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
