The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take legal action against the private respondents on the basis of complaint/representation dated 16.06.2021 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite representation/complaint dated 16.06.2021 (Annexure P-1) having been made to the authorities concerned, no action has been taken by the official respondents. He submits that petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to respondents No.2 to look into the complaint dated 16.06.2021 (Annexures P-1) submitted by the petitioners and take appropriate action under the provisions of law.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate

General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondents No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, Punjab is directed to look into the complaint of the petitioner representation/complaint dated 16.06.2021(Annexures P-1) and take appropriate steps/action, if any, required under the provisions of law. However, if the respondent No.2 does not find any substance or merit in the allegations levelled by the petitioner, much less, commission of cognizable offences, the petitioner would be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the apex Court in **Lalita Kumari** Vs. **Government of Uttar Pradesh and Others**; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
