The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.160 dated 18.09.2020 registered under Sections 21 and 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Division No.1, District Pathankot.

For the relief claimed in the present petition the petitioner had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M-17960-2021 – Jugal Kishore vs. State of Punjab which petition of his was dismissed on 29.04.2021 through the following order:-

“The arguments raised on behalf of the petitioner having not received a favourable response from the Bench and not to invite a decision on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioner at a later stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

A perusal of the afore quoted order reveals that the pleas raised on behalf of the petitioner having not received a favourable response from the Bench and only to prevent taking an order on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioner at a later stage, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner had sought withdrawal of his petition and taking a lenient view in the matter he was permitted to do so.

Admittedly, there is no change in circumstance after the dismissal of the petitioner's first petition for anticipatory bail through the aforesaid order.

Dismissed.
