This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to petitioner in case FIR No.61 dated 01.06.2021 under Sections 148, 323, 324 and 452 IPC read with Section 149 IPC (Sections 307 and 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Buta Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 30.07.2021, petitioner has already joined investigation and is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation. He further submits that after having obtained opinion of Doctor concerned, injury on the head of injured Gian Singh allegedly attributed to co-accused Gursewak Singh has been declared 'dangerous to life' and offence under Section 307 IPC has been added in the instant FIR.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that allegedly the petitioner has given *Kirpan* blow on the thigh of injured Budh Singh and the said injury has been declared 'simple in nature'.

In view of above, order dated 30.07.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
