Through this petition, the petitioner seek anticipatory bail in cross case bearing DDR No. 020 dated 25.04.2020 under Sections 452, 323, 326, 506, 148 and 149 IPC in FIR No. 0108 dated 24.04.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 506, 148 and 149 registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

It is the case in which the application moved by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail was dismissed vide order dated 27.08.2020 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

Thereafter, the petitioner approached the Hon'ble Supreme Court by way of filing Special Leave Petition i.e. Criminal Appeal No. 541 of 2021 arising out of SLP (Criminal) No. 4371 of 2021. The Hon'ble Supreme Court, after hearing the petitioner/appellant, set aside the impugned order dated 27.08.2020 passed by the co-ordinate bench of this Court vide which the bail application of the petitioner was dismissed and remanded the case back to this Court with a direction to the petitioner to join the investigation in the meantime.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Gudial Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner shall be released on *ad-interim* anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
