The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.26 dated 03.02.2021, registered for offences under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Though, the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused, Toti @ Jassi and Rita, but

the petitioner is involved in 6 other cases including two cases under the NDPS Act and another case registered under Section 174 IPC. The nature of allegations against the petitioner as well as her criminal past does not warrant grant of discretionary relief of anticipatory bail.

Petition is dismissed.

It is clarified that nothing said hereinabove shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
