The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 03.03.2021 under Sections 328, 354-C, 376(2)(n), 406, 506, 120-B of IPC and Section 3 of SC/ST 1989, registered at Women Police Station, Gurugram District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has since joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 30.07.2021, which was passed in the following terms:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that only role attributed to the petitioner in the FIR in question is of introducing the complainant to the main accused i.e. Abhijit Kumar for helping her to get a job. Learned counsel submits that a perusal of the allegations levelled in the FIR in question clearly reveal that no other role has been attributed to the petitioner and it was in fact the main accused Abhijit Kumar, who allegedly sexually exploited the complainant after putting her under threat.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Insp. Garima, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation. She further submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation/custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 30.07.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
