Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is owner of a house in Khud Mohalla, Ludhiana and the private respondents are her neighbours. It is further submitted that on account of some dispute regarding joint wall between houses of the petitioner and the private respondents, they are harassing the petitioner, who is a senior citizen. The allegations are that some times, the private respondents break up the plaster on the common wall or remove the water pipeline to harass the petitioner.

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Be whatsoever, on the face of it, it is a civil dispute between two parties, for which the appropriate remedy for the petitioner is to file a suit for permanent injunction, where the Civil Court can explore the possibility of settlement.

Since there is no order by the competent Court of law for the police to take action, I find that merely filing a complaint with the police do not disclose any cognizable offence, therefore, no direction can be issued to the police to take action, as the matter is of civil nature.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered as infructuous, however, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the competent Court of law, for redressal of her grievance, if any.
