1. Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

2. This is second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 100 dated 04.08.2019 under Sections 408, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

3. The earlier petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. was dismissed on 26.02.2021. During the pendency, the parties have compromised the matter.

4. Mr. R.S. Bajaj, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and admits the factum of compromise. The court is informed that a quashing petition is pending before this Court and parties have been directed to

get their statements recorded.

5. Considering the allegations in the FIR and compromise entered, agreeing to pay the amount in dispute in installments, the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to joining the investigation within one week. In the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He is directed to join the investigation as and when called for. He shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. The petition is allowed.

7. In case of failure of petitioner to join the investigation, the State would be at liberty to file an application for re-calling of this order.
