Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to change the duty timings/hours of the petitioner from night time to day time.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 04.07.2021 (P-3) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Bathinda to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 04.07.2021 (P-3) sympathetically keeping in view of his age in accordance with law by passing speaking order preferably within a period of four weeks from today.
