Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

The petitioners are seeking directions to the respondents to grant benefits of ACP and MACP to the petitioners who have retired from Border Security Force. Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that for the aforesaid relief claimed by the petitioners, they have already moved a representation dated 12.11.2019 (Annexure P-5) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation in view of judgment rendered by Delhi High Court in WP (C) No.3549 of 2018; Sunil Kumar Tyagi v. Union of India and another decided on 1.5.2019.

Notice of motion.

Mr. B.S. Kanwar, Standing Counsel for Union of India, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. He submits that the respondents have no problem in deciding the said representation but there is only one

difficulty that particulars of the service rendered by the petitioners are not there in the representation. So, he has made request that better particulars of the service of the petitioners be provided to the department.

In view of above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and of the claim made by the petitioners, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide representation (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of 6 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, in light of aforesaid judgment referred to by the petitioners and also in accordance with law.

The petitioners are at liberty to provide their better particulars of service to the respondents within next two months in light of objection raised by the respondents as has been discussed above.
